



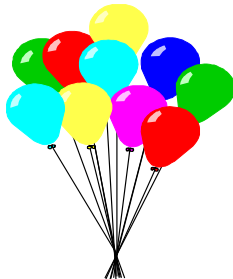
Looking Ahead at Some Important Dates—
